



NCAS Netball Umpire Head Coach 2019 Information and Application Pack

Background and Program Purpose

Netball NSW (NNSW) is committed to supporting umpires in their development by providing opportunities to increase their knowledge, gain experience, and develop and extend their personal attributes and competencies. Netball NSW will support the Regional Academies of Sport (RAS) for the development and support of pre-elite netball umpires.

The purpose of the program is to:

- Provide a training environment that allows the pre-elite umpires the opportunity to access quality services and programs as they progress through the NNSW and Netball Australia (NA) Umpire pathways.
- Implement the NNSW Umpire program, as set by NNSW in conjunction with the NA Umpire pathway.
- Prepare umpires for National badge accreditation awards.
- Provide umpire education and promote continuous improvement to develop the regions umpires.

Duties of this position

1. Attend program activities as listed below.
2. Provide training program/environment for the Academy umpires to learn and further develop their umpire skills.
3. Be available to coach and observe umpires in action (e.g. Regional League, etc.)

Qualifications, Experience and Selection Criteria

Highly desirable

1. To have achieved, or be working towards a National A badge.
2. Be a registered member of NNSW and have appropriate accreditation.

Mandatory Requirements

All Academy program staff are obliged to satisfy Child Protection Legislation requirements. All Academy program staff must hold a current and valid NSW Working With Children Check. All Academy program staff are considered volunteers and will be required to satisfactorily complete this check before they commence their role within the program.

*All NCAS Netball Staff are invited to attend the NNSW Regional High Performance Camp where coach and umpire specific sessions will be run by NNSW. While highly recommended, attendance to this event is not compulsory as part of the NCAS program. Attending staff will be responsible for travel, accommodation and food. Entry costs to this event will be covered by the Academy. For further information please contact the Academy office.

Remuneration

An annual honorarium of \$200.00 will be paid to the Umpire Head Coach at the completion of the program, once they have been assessed by the NCAS Executive Director as fulfilling their commitment to the program.

This amount is to help reimburse you for all incidental expenses such as fuel, phone calls, stationery, and similar incidental expenses that you have incurred in the competition of your duties.

No further claim for reimbursement of expenses can be claimed. Further information can be provided by the NCAS office upon enquiry.

Relationship

Your relationship with the Academy is voluntarily. There is no employee / employer relationship between you and the Academy.

Professional Development Support

All coaches and managers are allocated \$200.00 per program year to assist with any professional development expenses you may have incurred throughout the year. These funds cannot be rolled into consecutive programs if unused; and can only be used within the associated program year. Please contact the NCAS Office if you have a professional development opportunity to which you would like to allocate these funds.

Term

Umpire Head Coaches are contracted for one program term. Coaches may reapply for the role in consecutive programs.

Communications

The Umpire Head Coach will be required to communicate effectively with other program staff to support the success of the program. The Umpire Head Coach reports to the Sport Programs Manager.

The Umpire Head Coach may also liaise with the Academy's Executive Director from time to time in relation to the running of the program. The Umpire Head Coach is ultimately accountable to the Academy's Sports Program Committee.
