Program Overview

Supported by Jack Newton Junior Golf, the NCAS Golf Program has the specific objective of identifying talented junior golfers and providing them with a level of coaching and ancillary athlete education that will assist them in taking the next step in the sport of golf.

The program is designed to expose golfers to skills assessment and development designed by JNJG, new challenges and opportunities, and to complement any lessons / training you are receiving or have received. The NCAS Education Program will deliver modules in the following areas: Sports Psychology, Injury Prevention, Sports Nutrition, Drugs in Sport, and Strength & Conditioning.

The NCAS Golf Program will run a condensed program from March to June 2024.

Program Cost & Payment

The athlete levy of the 2024 NCAS Golf program is \$475.00 which includes:

- 4 x 1-day Training Sessions (includes lunches)
- 1 x 2-day Camp (Kew Junior Masters)
 - Accommodation, food, transport (during event) & coaching fees included
- Coaching from PGA Coaches and visiting elite JNJG coaches and specialists
- Course & venue hire fees
- Fitness testing
- Sport specific strength and conditioning programming
- Weekly S&C training sessions
- NCAS administration levy
- Athlete injury, death, and permanent disability insurance
- NCAS Education Program
- Athlete entry and meal at 2024 NCAS Academy Awards

NB: If, due to unforeseen circumstances the Academy is unable to deliver the entirety of the Golf Program, NCAS will consider partial refunds where appropriate.

Costs to be covered by athletes:

- NCAS uniform & golf polo
- Travel to and from Athlete Induction, Training Days, Education Program, Academy Games and Academy Awards.
- Accommodation for training days (if required), Education Program, and Academy Awards.
- Academy Games Tour fee
- Lunch and snacks at training days
- Strapping tape

'Your Local Club' Academy Games 2024

The 2024 Your Local Club Academy Games held in Wagga Wagga from 12-14th April 2024, will showcase some of the state's most talented emerging athletes across seven (7) sports including Basketball, Cycling, Golf, Hockey, Netball, Indoor Volleyball and Triathlon.

This is a compulsory event for selected athletes. JNJG & Golf NSW staff will be attending this event.

This event will operate as a live-in camp with a fee of \$550 + \$150 (optional bus travel)

The Academy Games fee will cover:

- 2 x nights (Fri & Sat) accommodation & meals (Breakfast & Lunch Sat & Sun, Dinner Fri & Sat). *Meals & snacks outside of this need to be covered by athletes
- Transport coach hire, fuel & associated expenses
- Venue & equipment hire
- Registration and Insurance
- Coaching expenses
- Athlete welcome pack

Where possible, we encourage families to organise their own transport to the Academy Games. NCAS have engaged the services of Simes Coaches to transport athletes to the Academy Games should they be unable to travel with family or their fellow teammates. The bus will leave from Ballina, with collection/drop off points between Ballina and Port Macquarie. The bus will travel overnight Thursday 11th April, returning Monday 15th April. Please note that seats are limited and there will be an additional cost involved per athlete. Athletes will be responsible for own meals whilst travelling. Please notify the Academy if you wish to reserve a seat.

Eligibility to apply

To be eligible for selection, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must be a current registered member of a NSW Golf Club in the North Coast catchment area.
- 2. Must reside within the Local Government boundaries of Tweed, Byron, Lismore, Ballina, Kyogle, Richmond River, Clarence Valley, Coffs Harbour, Bellingen, Nambucca, Kempsey and Port Macquarie-Hastings.
- 3. Within 12 years 17 years age in 2024, born 2007 2012.
- 4. Handicap of preferably 12 and under for Boys / preferably 18 and under for girls; all applicants will be considered on merit and potential.
- 5. Representing at school or club level as a minimum, preferably at a district level.
- 6. Must have a willingness to undertake a structured development program and abide by NCAS policies.
- 7. Preferably have golf as their primary sport played.
- 8. Complete and submit an application form by the due date.

Application Process

The selection process will follow the following steps:

- Prospective athletes submit an application form by 1st March 2024.
- 2. The Head Coach will select the squad based on information provided and may offer a trial day if required.

Selection Committee

The Selection Committee will consist of:

- The NCAS Head Coach
- A representative from Jack Newton Junior Golf
- NCAS Executive Member

Selection of athletes is based on development potential which includes factors such as age, performance history, attitude, coachability and not necessarily based purely on handicap.

For those athletes that are selected, you will receive a detailed offer to join the program which will include details on program dates, cost to athletes (the program is financially supported by the JNJG, however there will be an athlete levy to cover expenses determined from the program budget), uniform, insurance cover and NCAS athlete policies. This fee covers training session costs and will not necessarily cover all tour expenses; therefore, attendance at some events may incur further charges.

On behalf of JNJG and the NCAS, I extend my thanks to the athletes and their families who apply for a position in the program in the hope of gaining a new and rewarding experience.
